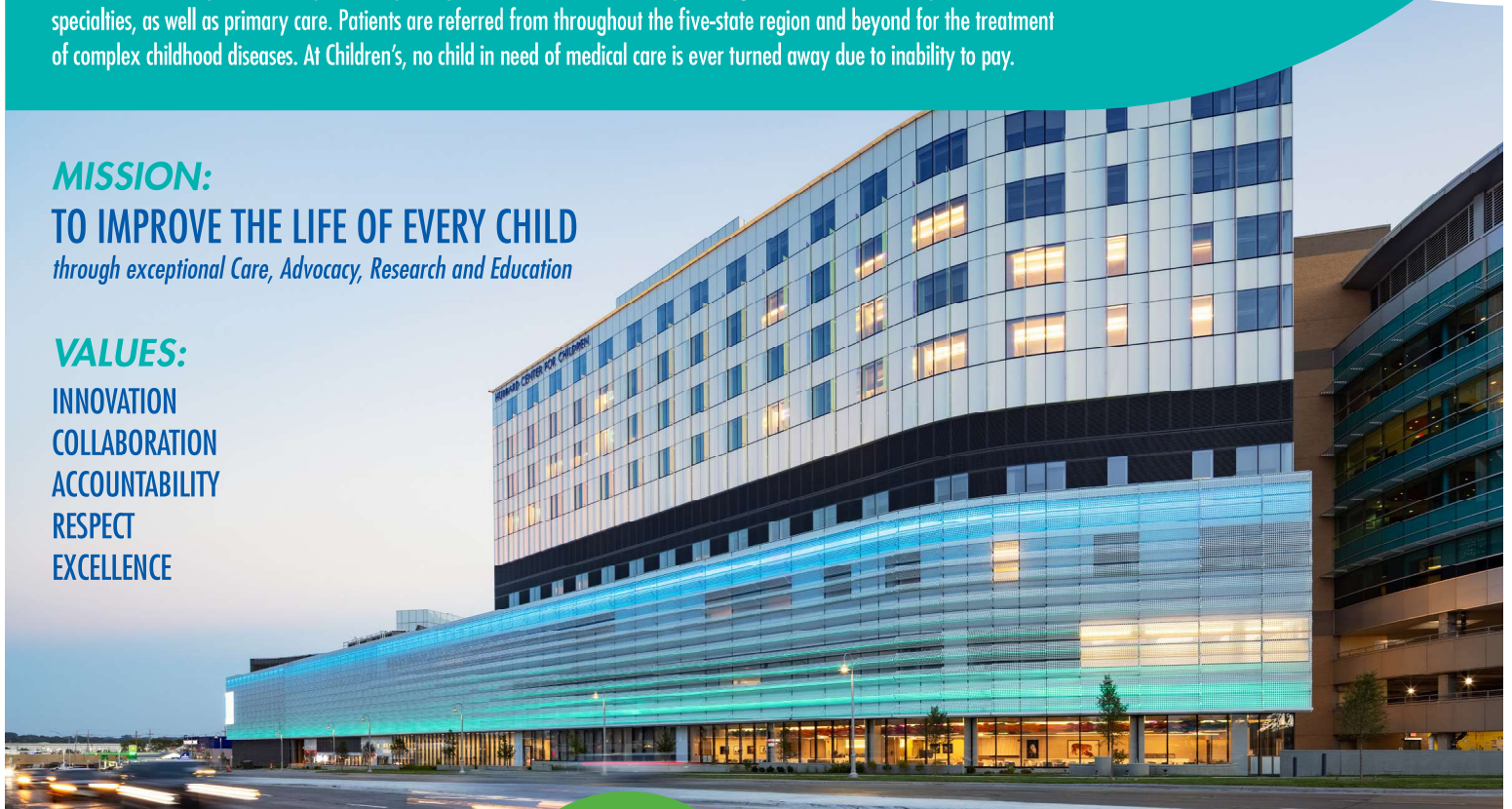

## EXCEPTIONAL PEDIATRIC SPECIALTY CARE

- Region's only Level IV Neonatal Intensive Care Unit with 48 beds, including two dedicated twin rooms
- Nebraska's only Level II Pediatric Trauma Center
- 32-bed Pediatric Intensive Care Unit with advanced life support therapies, including ECMO
- First-in-the-region 50-bed Cardiac Care Unit with advanced cardiac imaging and state-of-the-art interventional cardiac catheterization labs
- Fetal Care Center offering prenatal diagnostic services and care planning for mothers carrying babies who may need intervention or support after birth
- Accredited Critical Care Transport team equipped with a fleet of four ambulances, one helicopter and one fixed-wing plane, completing 2,666 transports in 2023

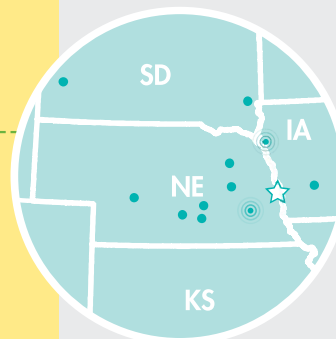

### BEHAVIORAL HEALTH URGENT CARE — KEARNEY

Set to open in 2024, Behavioral Health Urgent Care — Kearney is the first walk-in clinic of its kind in Nebraska, dedicated to helping children and adolescents up to 22 years of age showing signs of a behavioral or mental health crisis.

Opening in early 2026, in partnership with the Mental Health Innovation Foundation, the Behavioral Health & Wellness Center at Children's will provide a collaborative, world-class model of comprehensive behavioral and mental health care with inpatient, outpatient and partial hospitalization services, co-located with medical health needs.
