CHILDREN'S NEBRASKA, based in Omaha, Neb., is a 225-bed nonprofit organization caring for children since 1948. Children's is the only full-service pediatric specialty health center in Nebraska providing care in more than 50 pediatric specialties, as well as primary care. Patients are referred from throughout the five-state region and beyond for the treatment of complex childhood diseases. At Children's, no child in need of medical care is ever turned away due to inability to pay.



# **EXCEPTIONAL PEDIATRIC SPECIALTY CARE**

- Region's only Level IV Neonatal Intensive Care Unit with 48 beds, including two dedicated twin rooms
- Nebraska's only Level II Pediatric Trauma Center
- 32-bed Pediatric Intensive Care Unit with advanced life support therapies, including ECMO
- First-in-the-region 50-bed Cardiac Care Unit with advanced cardiac imaging and state-of-the-art interventional cardiac catheterization labs
- Fetal Care Center offering prenatal diagnostic services and care planning for mothers carrying babies who may need intervention or support after birth
- Accredited Critical Care Transport team equipped with a fleet of four ambulances, one helicopter and one fixedwing plane, completing 2,666 transports in 2023


